

Route A: Tynninghame to the coast at Tynninghame Links



Route A: The blue solid line shows the route. Places along the route mentioned in the text are labelled A1, A2, etc. Red lines show fences that cross or adjoin the route, most of which have barbed wire top strands. The white outline shows the boundary of private gardens at Tynninghame House and neighbouring properties. The dashed blue line shows a route from an alternative starting point running east from West Lodge (a1).

Start at point A1, the entrance to South Row, Tynninghame. Cross the A198 with care. Route A (blue on the map) goes east on the metalled track towards Tynninghame House. Turn left when you reach the first shelterbelt which starts after the first pasture field on the left. Follow the track running north within the shelterbelt, which is called the Dark Path. At the northern end of the Dark Path is a barrier which cannot be opened, but can be climbed over (Point A2 on the map).



Then follow a track running beside a metal irrigation pipe. The track curves around to the right. The field with the monument in it is on your right. This track ends at point A3, a padlocked gate into the Tynninghame House curtilage, which is a private garden you are not entitled to enter. The boundary of the private garden area is shown on the map by a white outline.



To the left of the gate at A3 are fences around a large pasture. These can be scaled, but they have barbed wire and are difficult to cross. If you can get over the fence, walk eastwards across the large pasture, heading immediately to the left of a horse paddock north of the Tynninghame House curtilage. There is a gate at Point A4 which is easy to open.



You are then in a pasture field with horse jumps in it. From point A4 follow the track north-eastwards to Tynninghame Links car park and the coast (blue line intersecting the northern edge of the map).

The map shows an alternative starting point at point a1. This can be reached from Tynninghame by walking with care north along the A198 to the first turning on the right at West Lodge. Please note that this is a private track and you must not park there or drive along it. Follow the dashed blue route eastwards from a1. This route intersects the main route just north of point A2.
